

Descendants of Daniel Brown, Sr.

1. Daniel¹ Brown, Sr. (?^A, Branch-One^B, (00Root-Brown)^C) was born 1744, and died Bef. June 30, 1835. He married (1) **Abigail Wardwell** Bef. 1778, daughter of Daniel Wardwell and Sarah Staples. She was born Bef. May 13, 1759. He married (2) **Nancy Pomeroy** Bef. 1795 in Charlotte Co., NB, daughter of Benjamin Pomeroy and Hannah Pierce. She was born November 01, 1777 in Wiscasset, ME, and died Unknown in Charlotte Co., NB. He married (3) **Hannah ???** Bef. 1835. She died Aft. 1835.

Notes for Daniel Brown, Sr.:

Penobscot Loyalist: no wife or children are shown in the Penobscot lists. He was either single in 1784 or the wife and children came later.

Parish of St. Stephen, Charlotte Co. Will dated 21 January 1832, proved 30 June 1835.

James Marshall and his wife Jane, my daughter, the farm, 50 acres, on which I reside, being half of Lot 127 in the [blank] Division of the Grants to Penobscot Loyalists. Son Richard, if living, the part of the farm between the creek and the river, otherwise the land to go to James Marshall. Granddaughter Elizabeth Michaels a cow. Sons John, Daniel, Malcolm, daughters Anne Collins and Abigail Paine each 10 shillings. James Marshall and wife Jane to maintain my wife Hannah and my daughter Catharine during their natural lives. James Marshall sole executor. Witnesses: David A. Rose, Neil McBean, James Smyth.

Inventory, dated 9 July 1832, valued at 249 pounds by Thomas Hannah and Joshua McBean."

Notes for Abigail Wardwell:

Some people show Abigail Wardwell married to a Daniel Perkins, 1752-1831. This seems unlikely based on the data found in "Loyalist Letters" p149, that names Abigail as the probable wife of Daniel Brown. Abigail seems to be the correct one based on the names of the children born to Daniel Brown and baptized in the Kirk McColl Church in St. Stephen, Charlotte Co., NB. More research required(AEK)

Penobscot Loyalist:

1784 List of Loyalists at Passamaquoddy as of 10 June 1784, indicates the following:

Adult Males: Richard & Benjamin

Adult Females: Nancy & Hannah

Children 10 and above: Mary, Betsey, Joseph, Benjamin, Hannah, and Lydia.

Children under 10: none shown????

Conflicting evidence:

The Loyalist list as shown above places the female, Nancy, as an adult and not as a child. The other major error in the list is that all of the children are shown as 10+ when the following should have been the distribution:

Mary, Elizabeth(Betsey), Joseph, and Benjamin should have been shown as 10+

Hannah, Nancy, and John should have been shown as under 10.

If dob for Nancy is correct then she could have been married 1792-

This data may not be correct. Marriage is shown in the Anglican Church Records for St. Andrews Parish. All that is known is that Anne Brown married a Collins, this is from the Probate of Daniel Brown, father of Anne.

Notes for John Brown:

The dates of b/d may not be correct for John Brown, s/o Daniel Brown. The information is from
Cemetery transcriptions for a cemetery in the same area as Daniel Brown had his Land Grant.

Kirk McColl Church Records shows the following:

"John Brown from the Old Ridge was buried 22 May 1825". Is this the John Brown shown here ???!
