Camp Tamarack is a residential academic summer camp for learning disabled children and teens. The camp is located 25 kms. Northwest of Prince Albert, SK

Qualifications:

- Completion of one year in a nursing program.

Job Description:

The Camp Nurse is responsible for the medical needs of campers and staff, as well as participating in the role of a Recreation Counsellor in the afternoons. The Camp Nurse is responsible to:

- Supervise medication, treatment and related care of campers.
- Establish contact with public health, community clinic and the hospital to provide well-coordinated treatment for campers.
- Stock and maintain infirmary.
- Work in a joint effort with the Camp Director to develop a recreation program that addresses specific needs of campers in one or more of the following areas: Archery, Canoeing, Nature Studies, Outdoor Skills, Swimming, Woodworking.
- Observe each camper's progress and provide adaptations to the camper's program as needed.
- Compile an end of camp summary outlining each camper's progress, areas of strength and areas that still require focus.
- Provide general care and supervision to a small group of campers in a cabin.
- Assist in providing supervision during large group activities, such as meals, campfire, and camp swim.
- To guide campers in work crews when assigned.
- To work for the common good of the camp, providing assistance to the directors and other staff as needed.

7 -week contracts are available starting June 26, 2010 and ending August 17, 2010. Staff members work 5 days on 2 days off per week.
