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## Information about French Immersion and Grade 10 French travel options

Usually French immersion high school students in grade 10 (or sometimes 9) have the option of doing a two week (including the one week of spring break) educational trip to France with their teachers. Sometimes the trip is an exchange or includes a short home stay. The teacher volunteer effort to make these trips possible is much appreciated.

Sometimes French immersion high school grade 10 students can elect to do a 1 to 3 month exchange, with a student in, for example, Quebec or France, where they attend each other's school together.
