THIS MATTER having come before this Court on August 16th, 1995, upon the Petitioner's Temporary Injunction on Domestic Violence and on the Notice of Hearing for Temporary Relief requested in the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage filed by Petitioner/Wife; and the parties having appeared and been represented by counsel; and the parties having orally stipulated to the relief requested in the Petition for Dissolution; and Court having conducted a hearing on the relief requested and having heard the testimony of the parties consenting to the stipulation; and being otherwise fully apprised in the premises, makes the following findings:

(1) That this Court has jurisdiction of this cause of action and of the parties hereto;

(2) That the Temporary Injunction shall be continued for one year;

(3) That Case No. 95-1352-CA-01 regarding the Order Continuing Injunction for One Year shall be consolidated into the Action for Dissolution under Case No. 95-1396-CA-01;

(4) That the Petitioner/Wife is in need of temporary support during the pendency of this action;

(5) That the Respondent/Husband shall have exclusive use and possession of the marital residence as of August 18th, 1995;

NOW, THEREFORE, upon due consideration of the foregoing, it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, as follows:

1. This Court has jurisdiction of this cause of action and of the parties hereto;

2. ONE YEAR INJUNCTION: This Injunction, previously entered under Case No. 95-1352-CA-01, shall be consolidated into the above-numbered action for dissolution, and shall remain in effect for a period of one (1) year, except as terms are specifically modified herein or by subsequent Order. To renew beyond one (1) year, Petitioner must file a petition in this case before the Injunction expires requesting an extension.

3. FILING FEES AND SERVICE OF PROCESS: Filing fees of \$92.50 and service of process fee of \$20.00 shall be paid by Respondent, THOMAS J. CROW, to the Clerk of the Circuit Court and Hernando County Sheriff's Department, within thirty (30) days of this Order.

4. DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ENJOINED: Respondent, THOMAS J. CROW, is enjoined from committing an assault, battery, or sexual battery on Petitioner, DIANA L. CROW, or any person related to the parties who is or was residing in the same home as Petitioner.

5. NO PERSONAL CONTACT: Respondent, THOMAS J. CROW, shall not come on any place where Petitioner is located, including Petitioner's residence, and shall not follow or shadow Petitioner at any place.

6. NO TELEPHONE CONTACT: Respondent, THOMAS J. CROW, shall not telephone Petitioner, except through an attorney.

7. PUNISHMENT: The parties may not agree to violate this Injunction and violation of any term of this Injunction is punishable by jail or fine. The Court may modify or dismiss this Injunction upon motion with notice to all parties.

8. DIRECTION TO LAW ENFORCEMENT: Law Enforcement is directed to enforce this Injunction and to assist Petitioner, DIANA L. CROW, in obtaining the benefits of this Order in a peaceable manner.

9. ARREST WITHOUT WARRANT: Pursuant to F.S. 901.15(6), any Law Enforcement Officer within the State of Florida may arrest Respondent, THOMAS J. CROW, without warrant for violating this Injunction when the Officer has probable cause to believe Respondent has knowingly committed an act of domestic violence of Paragraph numbered "4" of this Injunction. This paragraph does not limit or expand the Officer's arrest authority conferred by any other provision of law. (See F.S. 901.15 generally.)

10. As of August 18th, 1995, Respondent/Husband, THOMAS J. CROW, shall have exclusive use and possession of the marital residence located at 8280 Norbert Street, Spring Hill, FL. Further, Respondent shall be responsible for all expenses in connection with the maintenance and upkeep of the marital residence until further Order of this Court. Respondent/Husband shall also pay all existing monthly obligations of the parties.

11. Respondent/Husband, THOMAS J. CROW, shall pay \$500.00 per month as temporary support for Petitioner/Wife, commencing August 21st, 1995, and payable monthly thereafter on the 21st day of each month. Respondent is responsible for the 4% clerk's fees, minimum of \$1.25 and maximum of \$5.25. Said payments, in the total sum of \$505.25 per month, shall be made through the Central Depository of the Hernando County Clerk's Office.

12. Respondent/Husband shall maintain health insurance for Petitioner/Wife during the pendency of this action;

13. Respondent/Husband shall keep Petitioner/Wife as beneficiary on all life insurances policies obtained during the marriage until further Order of this Court;

14. Respondent/Husband shall have exclusive use and possession of the 1975 Lincoln Continental. Respondent shall be responsible for any obligations or expenses in connection with his possession of said car.




