# Hnaua Unitarian Centre

- The Hnaua Unitarian Centre is a private facility owned and operated by the Arborg Unitarian Church, Inc. In making its facilities available, it gives first priority to Unitarian groups and active members of Unitarian congregations and secondary priority to other nonprofit and public organizations whose purposes are in harmony with those of the Unitarian Universalist faith. The Hnaua Unitarian Centre is available for private rental at the discretion of the board of directors of the Arborg Unitarian Church, Inc., which reserves the right to limit or refuse rental as it sees fit.
- Alcohol may be served only if renters have secured the appropriate permit(s) from the Manitoba Liquor Control Commission. Renters assume all liability for any actions arising from the serving of alcohol at the centre. The serving of alcohol in the Chapel is expressly forbidden, except as part of a service of worship.
- Renters are expected to be respectful of the centre's neighbours, so as not to infringe upon our neighbour's reasonable enjoyment of their own property. Renters are expected to comply with all government legislation, including but not limited to the Rural Municipality of Bifrost's noise and burning bylaws.
- Renters will be held liable for any damage to the centre's buildings, grounds or contents, caused either by themselves or their guests. Renters are expected to clean up after themselves and, should they fail to do so, will be subject to a cleaning surcharge in addition to their rental fee.
- Smoking is expressly forbidden inside any of the centre's buildings.
- Overnight accommodation is not permitted in any of the centre's buildings. Renters wishing to overnight at the camp are expected to sleep in trailers, tents or the open.
- Motor vehicles and trailers are permitted in designated areas only and may not be driven or parked on the lake side of the centre's buildings.
- **Rates:** Available on request.
- Rental fees are not tax deductible and no charitable receipts can be issued.
