[POOL PLAYERS MUST ONLY COME FROM THE JUAN DE FUCA FC "OFFICIAL POOL"]

NOTE: ONLY Juan de Fuca FC will supply the **OFFICIAL POOL** players for any team that is short of player(s) for that game scheduled. If your team is short player(s), you **MUST** obtain extra player(s) from the **OFFICIAL POOL**. Any player(s) found not registered as part of the team playing for, or not from the **OFFICIAL POOL**, will be requested to cease playing or until the matter has been dealt with by the Tournament Director and/or the Disciplinary Committee. Prior to coming to the **OFFICIAL POOL**, be sure to know what relative positions of the player(s) are required. This will help us maintain enough available players for ALL teams.

Players **Over 40's** All players (except goalkeepers) **MUST** be over 40 years of age by Dec. 31.
Goalies **MUST** be over 35 by Dec. 31.

Under-age goalies may not play as a field player.

Over 48's All players (except goalkeepers) **MUST** be over 48 years of age by Dec. 31.
Goalies **MUST** be over 45 by Dec. 31.

Under-age goalies may not play as a field player.

Over 55's All players (including goalkeepers) **MUST** be over 55 years of age by Dec. 31.

Games 4 games guaranteed
Game duration 60 minutes, including Finals (two 30 minute halves)
Round Robin games may end in a tie (including any divisions that happen to be playing in a Round Robin format throughout the whole tournament)

Finals If tied at full time, game to be decided by penalty shots as per F.I.F.A. rules or as deemed by the Tournament Director and/or the Tournament Committee

Points

Points awarded as follows (to a maximum of 10 points per game)							
Wins	6 points	Lose	0 points	Tie	3 point	Shutout	1 point
Goals scored:	1 point for each goal scored to maximum of 3 goals						

For division(s) playing a Round Robin format, a winner is decided by "Total Points" then "Record Against Each Other" then "Goal Difference" then "Total Goals Scored" then "Penalty Shoot Out" and if that fails then by the Tournament Director and Tournament Committee

Cards

Yellow Cards: Three yellow cards may earn a one game suspension, at the discretion review by the Juan de Fuca Disciplinary Committee.

Red Cards: A red card will earn the present game ejection and any additional games suspensions (depending on the circumstance), upon be discretion review by the Juan de Fuca Disciplinary Committee..

Referees are encouraged to use a ten (10) minute cooling off period where ever possible.

THERE IS NO SLIDETACKLING ALLOWED

Alcohol

Alcohol will **ONLY** be consumed within the designated licensed area.

CONSUMING ALCOHOL OUTSIDE THE AREA & GET CAUGHT, WE ALL LOSE!!!

Especially if caught outside the designated licensed area by the park's personnel or local police authorities. These rules are for the safety of not only the players but also for the families, friends, and spectators that attend our tournament. If you should see someone consuming alcohol outside of the designated licensed area, please bring this to the attention of "**ANY**" Juan de Fuca FC team member and it shall be dealt with immediately and severely.

IMPORTANT THAT YOU READ THESE ADDITIONAL ITEMS:

1. GAMES BEING PLAYED ON MONDAY WILL BE POSTED AFTER THE FINAL GAME(S) PLAYED ON SUNDAY NIGHT. WE **RESERVE THE RIGHT TO CHANGE THE PLAYING SCHEDULE FOR MONDAYS GAME(s).**
2. WHEN YOU ARRIVE IN VICTORIA, ALL TEAMS ARE TO LEAVE A CONTACT PERSON AND A NUMBER WE CAN REACH YOU AT IN CASE THERE ARE ANY CHANGES TO OUR TOURNAMENT OR TO THE PLAYING SCHEDULE.
3. SOME TEAMS COME WITH PLAYERS THAT ARE ELLIGIBLE TO PLAY IN MORE THAN ONE DIVISION. THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE HAS THE RIGHT TO GRANT THOSE PLAYERS TO PLAY FOR MORE THAN ONE DIVISION. THESE PLAYERS MUST HAVE PLAYED FOR THE OTHER TEAM(S) FOR A MINIMUM OF ONE GAME DURING OUR TOURNAMENT. YOU CANNOT "**STACK**" A TEAM WITH UN-ELLIGIBLE PLAYERS.
