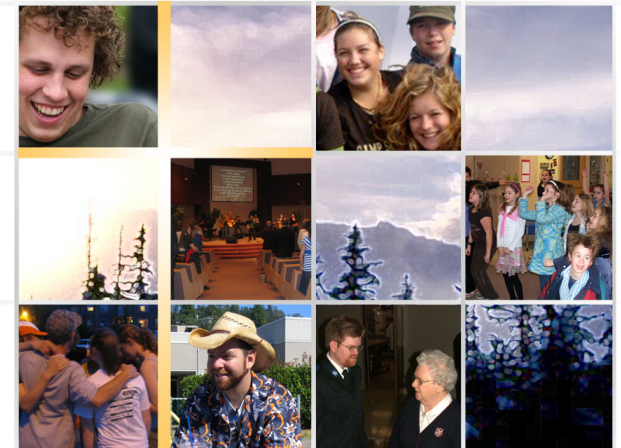

Weekly Programs for All Ages

Sunday Morning Service is at 10:00 a.m. The style is contemporary. After church, you are invited to stay and enjoy coffee and fellowship in the foyer and to visit the church library, which is open before and after the service.

Supervised Nursery Care is available for children under age 2½. There is also an infant and parent sitting room for your comfort. An usher will be happy to direct you to the nursery facilities.

Kids Time is for children ages 2½ to 11. They leave from the adult service – watch for the dismissal announcement. Parents, please pick up your children promptly from the Kids Centre after church.

Sunday Evening Service is held in the Dining Room, The coffee is on at 5:30 and the service starts at 6:00. This is where you can enjoy the hymns and traditional songs of The Salvation Army as well as excellent Bible teaching by a variety of leaders.

We offer a wide variety of mid-week activities, studies and care groups, as well as vibrant programs for children and teens. All of these are intended to provide ways to help you grow, to meet your needs, and to give you ways to connect with other people.
