

JACOB'S MAGICAL LADDER

Cubs and Scouts will find this craft very intriguing.

To make it, each member will need five pieces of 1/4" thick wood (cut 2" x 3"); 12 strips of 1/2" wide ribbon or fabric tapes, cut 4 1/2" long; and 15 thumb tacks (size 3/8").

1. Attach three tapes to four of the pieces of wood at the positions shown. (See diagram below)
2. Turn the four taped pieces upside down and fold over the tapes as shown.
3. Crease the tapes by pressing firmly against the corners.
4. Position the next taped piece exactly over the first. Next, fold the bottom tapes up over the piece of wood.
5. Tack the bottom tapes neither too loosely, nor too tightly.
6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 for succeeding taped pieces, and attach the last untaped piece of wood as shown in the diagram below. λ
