***Hot Jamz Radio/KMIH + KMCQ to move to
NEW frequencies this coming weekend!***

Mr. Hal Rose, Executive Vice President of First Broadcasting Capital Partners, and Nick DeVogel, General Manager of KMIH-FM mutually announce that a brand new commercial FM radio station for the Seattle-Tacoma radio market (KMCQ) will begin broadcasting in Seattle on 104.5 FM beginning in September.

To facilitate this new radio station and move-in of KMCQ to the Seattle area, **KMIH will move its current broadcast operations from 104.5 fm to 88.9 fm this coming Sunday, 8/31/08**

“This is a long awaited move for us” said Nick DeVogel, General Manager of Hot Jamz radio/KMIH-FM. “It is the perfect time for us to move now with the pending start of the new school year”. Listeners will hear an improved station with greater emphasis on students and programming to our community. KMIH is also set to launch a radio translator in Seattle on 94.5 fm in late September to help listeners better hear the main signal while driving in their cars. “We are proud to begin serving Covington and the Seattle area and were extremely pleased that we were able to work with KMIH and the Mercer Island School District to find a way to improve their signal in Seattle,” said Hal Rose, EVP of First Broadcasting.

KMIH-FM is an educational radio program operated by the Mercer Island School District. KMIH has been on the air serving the community since 1969. KMIH teaches students the essential skills in broadcast media while successfully reaching over 26,000 listeners per week* in the greater Seattle area.
