



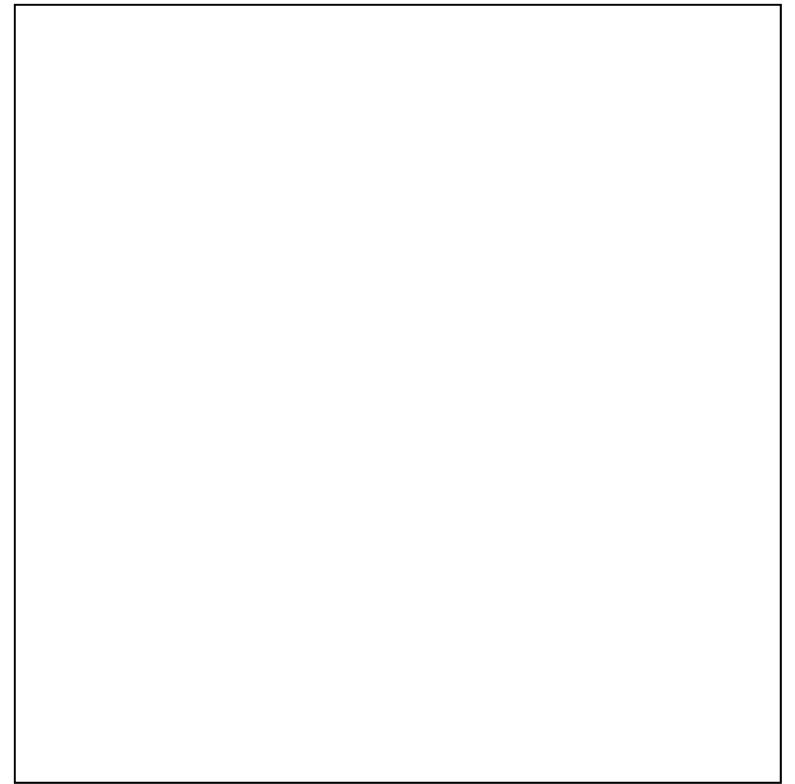

Winter is a wonderful time with lots of wonderful celebrations! The best part is that we all spend time with our families and friends.

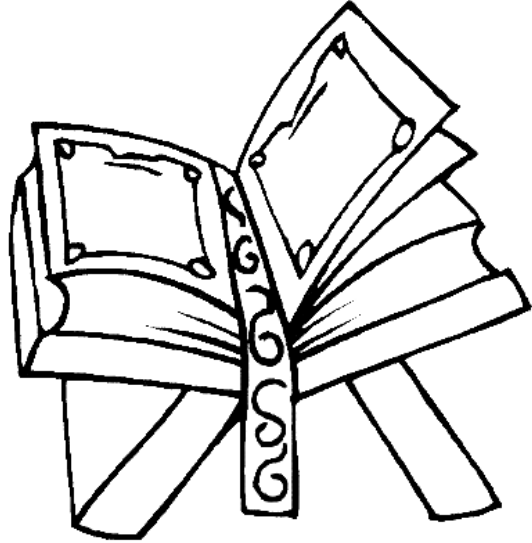
Draw your family at your winter celebration.
