



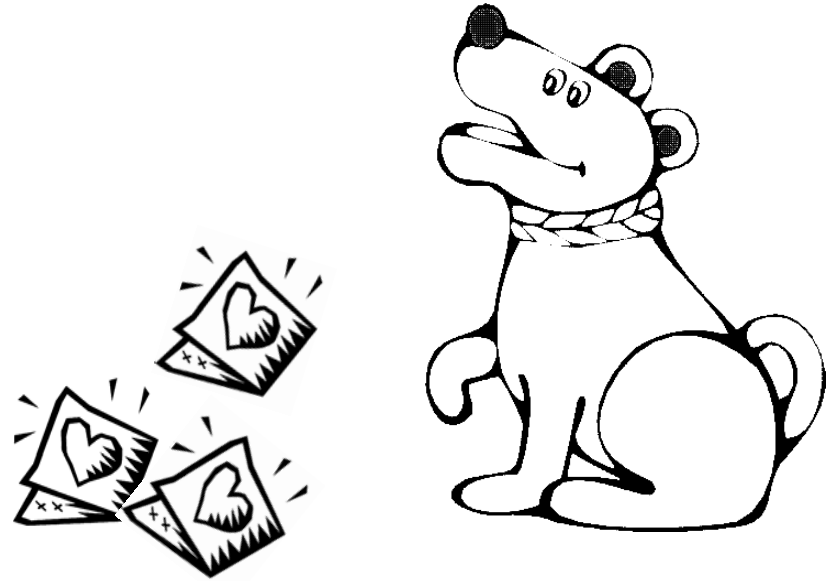

Tomorrow would be Valentine's Day! That night, before bed, Sam made nice Valentine cards for all the friends in his class.

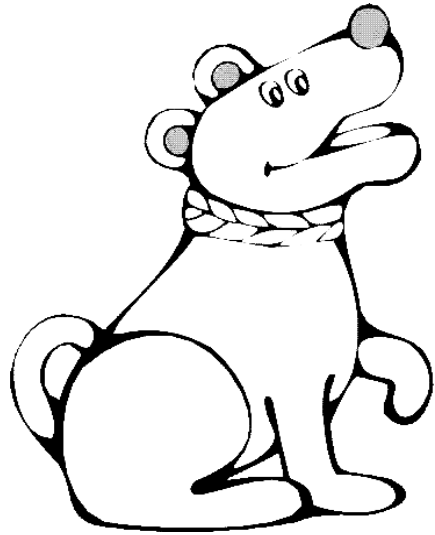


Then Sam saw that Ruff had his cards! He dropped them carefully on the ground.

"Oh, Ruff, thank you!" said Sam. "The wind must have blown them out of the wagon!"

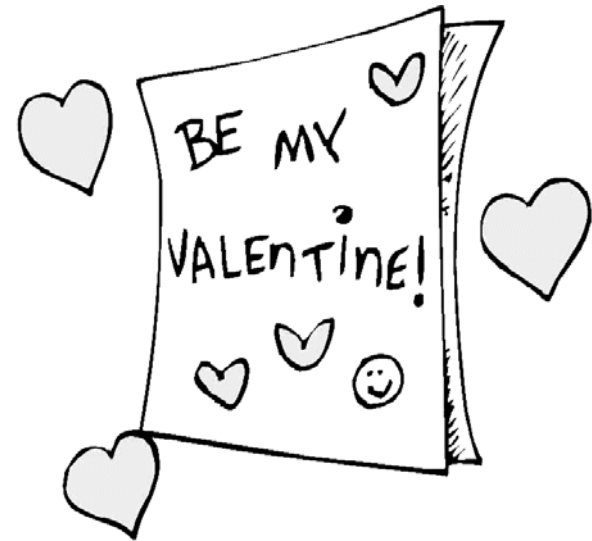
He gave Ruff a big hug. All the children called Ruff the Valentine Dog!

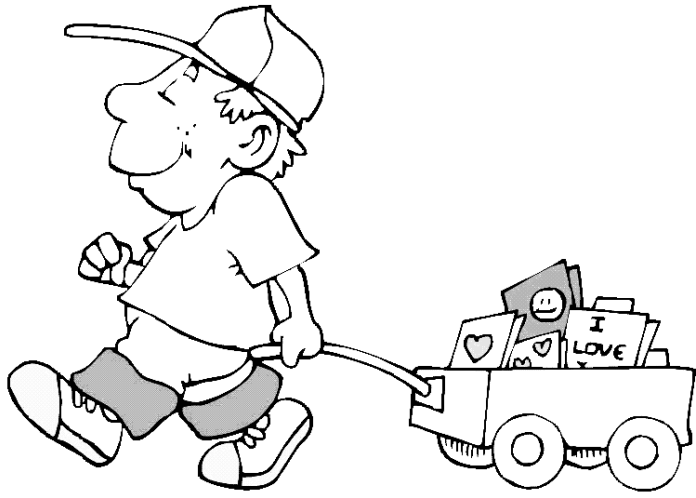
