Help keep the Earth beautiful by working to keep your yard, your school yard and your neighborhood clean.

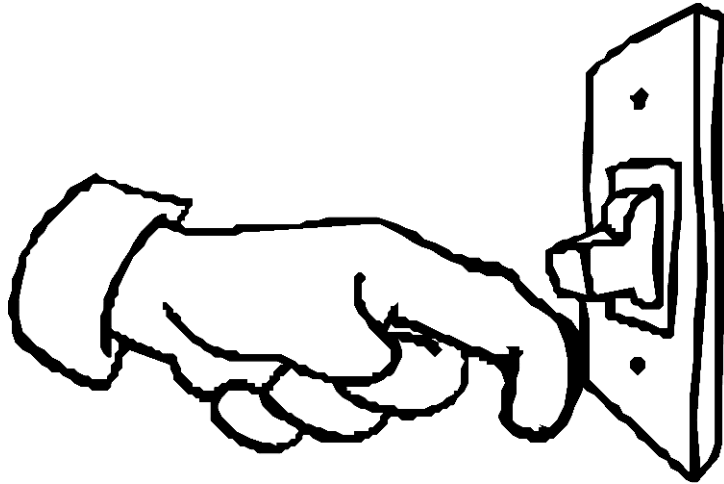
Never litter, and help to clean up your part of the world. Litter is ugly.
