

Colin Redekop completed his undergraduate studies in Winnipeg. Studying with Richard Greig, he earned the Colleague diploma of the RCCO in 1995. In 1999, he completed the Master of Church Music degree at Southern Seminary, studying with Dr. Boyd Jones.

From 2000 – 2003, Colin served the Community Church of Vero Beach, Florida as both Associate Music Director/Organist and Interim Music Director/Organist, overseeing a comprehensive program of services, choirs and concerts. He was also very active in the musical life of Indian River County, performing organ recitals, accompanying numerous school and community choirs, and serving on the local board of the AGO.

Since returning to Winnipeg, Colin has served as the music director of the Portage Avenue Church, president of the chamber choir Reign of Sound and accompanist of the Winnipeg Mennonite Children's Choir. He has continued organ studies with Richard Greig. Recent awards at the Winnipeg Music Festival include the Winnipeg Bach Festival Trophy (2005) and the Lieutenant Governor's Trophy (2006).

In September, Colin will enter the Master in Music program in organ performance at the University of Calgary, studying with Neil Cockburn. He will also serve as the organist of Grace Presbyterian Church.
