

Thomas Packham grew up in Saskatoon. He graduated from the University of Saskatchewan and studied organ with Henry T. Abley at St. John's Cathedral, Saskatoon.

Most of his teaching career was spent in Regina. He served as Organist/Choirmaster of St. Paul's Cathedral (1976-1983), then Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church (1984-2004).

After retiring from teaching, he moved to Winnipeg in July, 2004. After a year as Organist/Choir Director of St. Paul's, Fort Garry (2004-05), he was appointed Director of Music at St. John's Cathedral (2005-present).

Earlier this year, Tom was elected President of the RCCO, Winnipeg Centre.
