

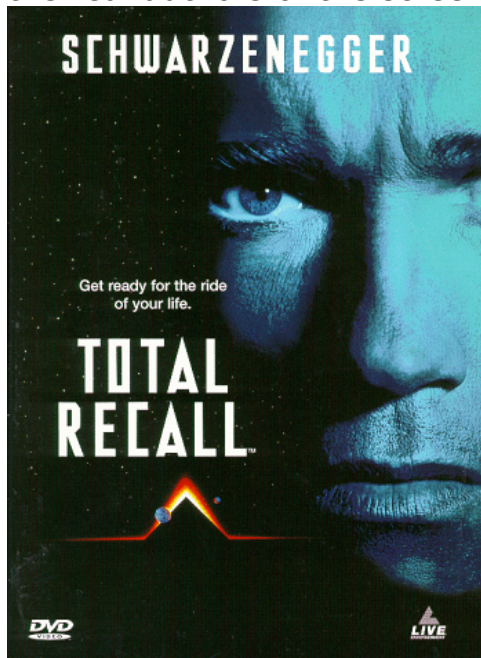

## JONASSON ACCUSES SCHWARZENEGGER OF 13-YEAR CAMPAIGN TO UNSEAT GOV. DAVIS

WINNIPEG, MANITOBA (CRAP: Canadian Regional Associated Press) – Campaigning from his home in Winnipeg, Canada, California gubernatorial candidate Stefan Jonasson accused his opponent Arnold Schwarzenegger of staging a 13-year campaign to topple Governor Gray Davis. “Isn’t it obvious to everyone that Schwarzenegger’s film *Total Recall* was a coded message to his supporters to undermine the current administration in Sacramento?” asked Jonasson. “I’m confident that a thorough investigation will show that the real authors of the screenplay for *Total Recall* were none other than the

comedy team of Cheney, Rumsfeld and Wolfowitz, who are thought by some to have written *Defense Strategy for the 1990s*, a musical that never made it to the stage but which was adopted as official U.S. policy by mistake. It’s brilliant, really -- they began the systematic destruction of the Davis administration even before they knew that Gray Davis would be governor!”

“What subliminal messages will we find in Schwarzenegger’s other films?” asked Jonasson, who is considered by some to be little more than a long-shot contender in his campaign to succeed Gray Davis, should the governor be unseated in the upcoming recall election. “Is it too much to think that *Kindergarten Cop* betrays Schwarzenegger’s plan to introduce airport-level security in the state’s nursery schools and primary grades? And what about *Twins*? Will Danny Devito be used as a body double for Schwarzenegger, much like Saddam Hussein used look-alikes to shelter himself from public exposure? People want access to their governor, not

some clone – no matter how striking the physical resemblance may be. The people of California have a right to know which of Arnold’s movies are really thinly-veiled plans for how he intends to run the state government.”

Jonasson denied suggestions that his attack on Schwarzenegger stems from a grudge he holds against the actor-turned-politician for pointing a handgun at Sharon Stone in a scene from *Total Recall*. He also insisted that his remarks were in no way an attempt to even the score because Stone’s name had not been featured prominently on the cover of the video when it was released. However, Jonasson is reported to have told a personal friend that he would not have entered the race if Sharon Stone had sought the governorship rather than Schwarzenegger.
