JONASSON GETS TOUGH ON AGING CRIMINALS

WINNIPEG, MANITOBA (CRAP: Canadian Regional Associated Press) – Sensitive to growing criticism that his anti-crime platform emphasizes the need to deal with juvenile crime while ignoring the growing incidence of geriatric crime, California gubernatorial candidate Stefan Jonasson has promised to “get tough” with elderly criminals.

“I won’t stand for older residents – many of the them expatriate Canadians and Minnesotans – harassing and terrorizing the law-abiding people of this state. Geriatric crime has got to stop!”

Jonasson has promised to convert at least one hundred personal care homes into privately-managed geriatric penitentiaries by the end of his first term in office. He also unveiled a plan to sell the Los Angeles Police Department to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, claiming that response times could be cut in half if police responded on horseback, thereby avoiding the traffic congestion of Los Angeles streets and freeways.

The candidate also pledged to eliminate the death penalty for those convicted of capital crimes committed after reaching the age of 55. “Let’s face it,” he said, “if
