3. Jóhann Pétur Ottó Jónasson (born Þorkelsson) – b. 10 Oct 1904 at Ytri-Búðir in Eyri parish (Eyrarsókn), Bolungarvík, Ísafjörðursýsla; d. 1 Nov 1939 in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Dairyman. = Ásrún Vopnfjord – b. 12 Sep 1903 at Laufás in Husavík, Manitoba; d. 2 Dec 1980 in Ladner, British Columbia. Retail sales clerk and homemaker. (See 3rd Branch)
4. Þorkell Guðmundsson – b. 11 Sep 1870 at Brekkur in Fljótshlíð, Rangárvallasýsla; d. 10 Sep 1910 in Eyri parish (Eyrarsókn), Bolungarvík, Ísafjörðursýsla. Carpenter. = Guðrún Jóhanna Ámundadóttir – b. 7 Feb 1882 at Bjóla in Ásahreppur (now Djúpárhreppur), Rangárvallasýsla [Oddi parish]; d. 7 Mar 1970 in Gimli, Manitoba. Housewife. (See 5th Branch)
5. Guðmundur Þorkelsson – 3 Jun 1828 at Ljótastaðir, Kross parish, Austur-Landeyjar; d. 10 Jan 1904 in Austur-Landeyjar. Farmer and craftsman at Brekkur in Fljótshlíð. = Ólöf Jónsdóttir – b. 28 Aug 1843 at Hliðarendi in Fljótshlíð. (See 9th Branch)
6. Þorkell Jónsson – 30 Mar 1799 in Austur-Landeyjar; d. 15 Jul 1879 in Austur-Landeyjar. Farmer and craftsman at Ljótastaðir in Austur-Landeyjar. = Guðrún Guðmundsdóttir – b. 23 Dec 1803 at Kirkjuland in Austur-Landeyjar; d. 4 Jun 1873 in Austur-Landeyjar.
7. Jón Þorkelsson – b. 1766; d. 2 Apr 1842. Farmer and craftsman at Efri-Úlfsstaðir, 1792-1798; Ljótastaðir in Austur-Landeyjar, 1798-1824; and Snotra in Austur-Landeyjar, 1824-1831. = Margrét Hreinsdóttir – b. 1765 at Skíðbakkahjáleiga in Austur-Landeyjar; d. 18 Jul 1834.
8. Þorkell Grímsson – b. 1729; d. 17 Sep 1806 at Ljótastaðir in Austur-Landeyjar. Farmer at Syðri-Úlfsstaðir in Austur-Landeyjar, 1759-1799. = Guðrún Jónsdóttir – b. 1731.
9. Grímur Jónsson – b. 1696. Farmer at Vestari-Klasbarði in Vestur-Landeyjar, where he is listed as residing in 1729; then at Voðmúlsstaðir in Austur-Landeyjar, where he appears in the census of both 1733 and 1753. = Ingibjörg 'yngri' Þorkelsdóttir – b. 1692; d. 22 Nov 1767.
10. Jón Þorgeirsson – b. 1662. Farmer at Skúmsstaðir in Vestur-Landeyjar and later at Gerðar in Vestur-Landeyjar, where he resided at the time of the 1703 census. = Þorgerður Árnadóttir – b. 1665.

2. Eileen Margaret Dipple – b. in St. Boniface, Manitoba. Cost accountant and later homemaker.
3. Charles Henry Dipple – b. 10 Oct 1882 in Acton, North Dakota; d. 16 Apr 1952 in St. James, Manitoba. Farmer at Sanford, Manitoba, 1900-1925; construction worker and caretaker in Winnipeg, 1925-1927; compressor operator for the Canada Cement Company, 1927-1950. = Eva Marie Lamontagne – b. 28 Nov 1898 in Oakwood, North Dakota; d. 13 Feb 1967 in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Homemaker. (See 4th Branch)
4. John Dipple – b. 29 Jul 1853 in Hesse-Darmstadt, Germany; d. 19 Mar 1926 in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Farmer at Pilkington, Ontario, 1874-1880; Acton, North Dakota, 1880-1903; and Sanford, Manitoba, 1903-1920. Road overseer, Acton Township, 1883-1884 and 1888-1889; treasurer, School District 57, 1883-1890; board of supervisors, Acton Township, 1885-1896. = Elizabeth Gemmer – b. 12 Jun 1854 in South Easthope, Ontario; d. 19 Nov 1941 in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Housewife. (See 7th Branch)
5. Nicolaus Dippel – b. 1819 in Hesse-Darmstadt, Germany; d. 27 Feb 1897 in Grafton, North Dakota. Farmer at Woolwich, Ontario, c. 1856-1860; Pilkington, Ontario, c. 1861-1880; Acton, Dakota Territory, 1880-1883. = Helena Schmidt – b. 23 Jun 1821 in Hesse-Darmstadt, Germany; d. 5 Jul 1910 in Mohall, North Dakota. (See 13th Branch)

3rd Branch – The Vopnfjord Family

3. Ásrún Jakobsdóttir Vopnfjord – b. 12 Sep 1903 at Laufás in Husavík, Manitoba; d. 2 Dec 1980 in Ladner, British Columbia. Retail sales clerk and homemaker.
4. Jakob Jónsson Vopnfjörð – b. 13 Apr 1875 at Bakkar in Vopnafjörður, Norður-Múlasýsla; d. 18 May 1951 in Blaine, Washington. Foster child at Márssel in Kirkjubæjarsókn, 1880. Tailor in Iceland before 1900; farm laborer at Laufás in Husavík, Manitoba, 1900-1906; farmer at Laufás, 1906-1908; dairyman in St. James, Manitoba, 1910-1925; resident in Cloverdale, British Columbia, 1930-1937; and resident in Blaine, Washington, 1937-1951. = Dagbjört Elíasdóttir Kjærnested – b. 28 Jun 1878 at Borg in Miklaholt, Hnappdalasýsla; d. 1 Jan 1972 in Bellingham, Washington. Housewife. (See 6th Branch)
5. Jón *skörsi* Jónsson – b. 6 Sep 1830 at Mið-Samtún in Glæsibæjarhreppur, Eyjafjörðarsýsla; d. circa 1924 in Reykjavík. Foster child at Naust in Hrafnagilssókn from 1835. Farm laborer at Skoruvík in Sauðaneshreppur, Norður-Þingeyjarsýsla, 1859-1861; farmer at Bakkar in Vopnafjörður (probably Svínabakkar), 1861-1879; Sleðbrjótur in Hróarstung, Norður-Múlasýsla, 1879; farm laborer at Ketilsstaðir in Kirkjubæjarsókn, 1880; farmer at Fagradal in Hofssókn, 1890; *leigjandi* (tenant or lodger) at Femri Vogur in Vopnafjarðarsýsla, 1910. = Kristín Jónsdóttir – b. 16 Apr 1836 at Þorbrandsstaðir in Vopnafjörður, Norður-Múlasýsla; d. 30 Jun 1894 at Vakurstaðir in Hofssókn. (See 11th Branch)
6. Jón Jónsson – b. 1791; d. 29 Dec 1838 at Stóra-Eyjarland in Hrafnagil, Eyjafjörðarsýsla. Kristbjörg Jónsdóttir – b. poss. 1798, at Neðri-Glerá in Kræklingahlíð; d. 5 May 1856 at Brimnes in Fáskrúðsfjörður, Suður-Múlasýsla. [If Kristbjörg's birth information is correct, then she was the daughter of Jón Ólafsson of Stóra-Eyjarland and Margrét Steinsdóttir.]
7. Jón Benediktsson – b. 1751 in Möðruvallaklaustursókn; d. 1 Mar 1830 in Hrafnagilssókn. Farmer at Vöglum and Laugaland in Þelamörk. (Son of Margrét Jónsdóttir, 1729-1807, and grandson of Jón Jónsson, 1700-1758.) = Oddný Þorvaldsdóttir – b. 1754; d. 1799.

8. Benedikt Guðmundsson – b. 1720; d. 1773. Farmer at Krossastaðir in belamörk. = Margrét Jónsdóttir – b. 1729; d. 1807.
9. Guðmundur Jónsson – b. 1669 at Höfði in Höfðaströnd, Skagafjarðarsýsla; d. 5 May 1748. = Sigríður Þorkelsdóttir – b. 1675.

4th Branch – The Lamontagne Family

3. Eva Marie Lamontagne – b. 28 Nov 1898 in Oakwood, North Dakota; d. 13 Feb 1967 in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Retail sales clerk, seamstress and housewife.
4. George Achille Lamontagne – b. 1 May 1867 near St-Pierre-de-Broughton, Co. Mégantic, Québec; d. 27 Mar 1943 in St. Boniface, Manitoba, and buried at LaSalle, Manitoba. Laborer and farmer. = Cleophe Pageot – b. Dec 1875 in St-Elzéar, Co. Beauce, Québec; d. 22 Apr 1913 in Oakwood, North Dakota. (See 8th Branch)
5. Augustin Lamontagne – b. 10 Feb 1828 at either St-Michel de Bellechasse or near St-Marie de Beauce, Québec; d. 27 Mar 1916 at Thetford Mines, Québec. Day laborer. = Rosalie Fontaine – b. circa 1837; died sometime after 1876.
6. Amable Bacquet dit Lamontagne – b. circa 1788 at St-Michel de Bellechasse, Québec; d. sometime after 1851.
7. Amable Bacquet dit Lamontagne – b. circa 1761/62 at St-Michel de Bellechasse, Québec; d. probably after 1810. Farmer. = Marie-Anne Patry – chr. 1 Aug 1762 at St-Michel de Bellechasse, Québec; d. prob. after 1810.
8. Joseph Bacquet dit Lamontagne – chr. 18 May 1720, probably at St-Michel de Bellechasse; d. probably after 1762. Farmer. = Agathe Goupil – chr. 7 Feb 1729 at St-Vallier, Québec; d. probably after 1762.
9. François Bacquet dit Lamontagne – b. circa 1681/82 at St-Michel de Bellechasse, Québec; d. 18 Oct 1744 at St-Michel de Bellechasse, Québec. Farmer. = Elisabeth Guenet – chr. poss. 20 Jan 1692 at Lévis, Québec; d. 7 Mar 1934 at St-Vallier, Québec.
10. François Bacquet dit Lamontagne – b. 1636 (or 1646) at Montjoie in Bordeaux, France; d. 10 Apr 1701, Québec. Farmer. = Anne Philippe – b. 1653; d. 1 May 1715 at St-Michel de Bellechasse, Québec.
11. Renaud Bacquet – resident of Montjoie in Bordeaux, France. = Jeanne Montus.

5th Branch – The Family at Bjóla í Djúparhreppur

4. Guðrún Jóhanna Ámundadóttir – b. 7 Feb 1882 at Bjóla in Oddi, Rangárvallasýsla; d. 7 Mar 1970 in Gimli, Manitoba. Housewife. =(1) Þorkell Guðmundsson – b. 11 Sep 1870 at Brekkur in Fljótshlíð, Rangárvallasýsla; d. 10 Sep 1910 in Eyri, Ísafjörðarsýsla. Carpenter. [= (2) Jónas Jónasson – b. 29 Jan 1866 at Barkarstaðir in Tórfastaðahreppur, Vestur-Húnavatnssýsla; d. 16 Sep 1941 in Reykjavík, Iceland. Merchant and dairyman. Jónas was the son of Jónas Guðmundsson and Helga Stefánsdóttir. He is generally associated with the farmstead Húkur.]
5. Ámundi Filippusson – b. 28 Apr 1845 at Bjóla in Oddi, Rangárvallasýsla; d. 4 Feb 1916 at Önundarholt in Hraungerði and Gaulverjabær parishes, Árnessýsla. Farmer at Bjóla in Djúparhreppur, Rangárvallasýsla. = Ragnheiður Eyjólfadóttir – b. 29 Oct 1848 at

Þorlákshöfn in Árnessýsla; d. 21 Sep 1936 in Hafnarfjörður in Gullbringusýsla.
Housewife. (See 10th Branch)

6. Filippus Þorsteinsson – b. 1799; d. 20 Feb 1885. Farmer at Bjóla and director of the poor-law district. = Sigríður Jónsdóttir.
7. Þorsteinn Vigfússon – b. 1769; d. 27 Apr 1825. Farmer and weaver at Bjóla.
8. Vigfús Nikulásson – b. 1733; d. ? Farmer at Leiðolfstaðir in Flói and member of the legislature.
9. Nikulás Jónsson – b. 1682; d. 1750. Farmer and silversmith at Suður-Reykir in Mossfellsveit and later at Ásgautsstaðir.
10. Jón Jónsson – b. ?; d. after 1703. Farmer at Melshús in Seltjarnarnes.
11. Jón Ólafsson of Reykjavík. Member of the legislature in the Kjalarnes district from 1671 until 1694. = Guðný Engilbertsdóttir, the daughter of Séra Engilbert Nikulásson (1598-27 Nov 1668), minister at Þingvellir from 2 Jul 1617 until his death.
12. Ólafur Eyjólfsson of Reykjavík in Seltjarnarnes. Member of the legislature in the Kjalarnes district and member of the Alþing from 1648 until 1663. = Guðrún Ásgautsdóttir.

5. Elías Jónsson Kjærnested – b. 25 Dec 1831 at Múnaðarhóll; d. 1 Sep 1906 at Laufás in Husavík, Manitoba. Farmer at Múnaðarhóll and, after 1871, at Borg in Miklaholt; Justice of the Peace; farmer at Laufás in Husavík, Manitoba. [= Ólöf Þorsteinsdóttir – b. 20 May 1830 at Kjálvegur near Ingjaldshóll; d. 29 Jan 1916 at Gimli, Manitoba.] = (c) Ólöf Davíðsdóttir – b. 16 Mar 1854 in Setbergssókn, Snæfellssýsla; d. 7 March 1917 in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Schoolteacher. (See 12th Branch)
6. Jón Þorláksson Kjærnested – b. 6 Jun 1799 at Hvamkastar, Iceland; d. 25 Jun 1836 at Ólafsvík. Agriculturalist and district administrator. = Elín Elíasdóttir – b. 1806; d. 1869.
7. Þorlákur *yngr*i Hallgrímsson *dannebrogsmaður* of Skriða – b. 14 Sep 1754; d. 6 Oct 1846. Agriculturalist and manufacturer. = Margrét Björnsdóttir.
8. Hallgrímur Jónsson – b. 2 May/Dec 1717 at Naust in Eyjafjörður; d. 25 Sep 1785 at Miklagarði. Farmer, woodcarver and painter at Naust, 1738-1743; at Kjarni in Eyjafjörður, 1743-1752; at Halldórstaðir in Laxárdal, 1752-1755; at Kasthvammur in Aðaldal, 1755-1771. Resident at Upsir in Upsaströnd, 1771-1785. = Halldóra Þorlákssdóttir – b. 1717, prob. at Ásgeirsbrekka in Viðvíkursveir; d. 12 Nov 1794, prob. at Upsir.
9. Jón Hallgrímsson of Naust – b. 1684; d. 1746. Farmer at Ytragil in Eyjafjörður and Naust in Eyjafjörður. = Ólöf Jónsdóttir – b. 1677; d. 1741.
10. Hallgrímur Sigurðsson – b. circa 1645. Farmer at Naust in Eyjafjörður. = Halldóra Sigurðardóttir – b. Circa 1650.
11. Sigurður Sæmundsson – b. circa 1600. Farmer in the Eyjafjörður district. = Engilráð Nikulásdóttir – b. circa 1600 at Rúgsstaðir in Eyjafjörður.
12. Sæmundur Jónsson – b. circa 1540. Farmer at Samkomugerði in Eyjafjörður.

13. Jón Gunnsteinsson – b. circa 1512.

4. Elizabeth Gemmer – b. 12 Jun 1854 in South Easthope, Ontario; d. 19 Nov 1941 in Winnipeg, Manitoba.
5. John Gemmer – b. 27 Jun 1821 in Hesse-Darmstadt, Germany; d. 9 Nov 1904 in South Easthope Township, Ontario, and is buried in Tavistock. Farmer. = Catherine Becker – b. 5 Jan 1831 in Hesse-Darmstadt, Germany; d. 11 Jun 1886 in South Easthope Township, Ontario, and is buried at Tavistock. (See 14th Branch)

4. Cleophe Pageot – b. Dec 1875 in St-Elzéar, Co. Beauce, Québec; d. 22 Apr 1913 in Oakwood, North Dakota.
5. Alexandre Pageot – b. prob. 1838, prob. at St-Elzéar, Co. Beauce, Québec; d. 19/20 Mar 1907 at Oakwood, North Dakota. Farmer. = Rose-Delima Morel – b. prob. 1839 at St-Anne de Beaupré, Co. Montmorency, Québec; d. 23 Mar 1916.
6. Alexandre Pageot – b. circa 1805 at either Charlesbourg or near Ste-Marie, Québec; d. after 1871, prob. at St-Elzéar, Québec. Farmer. = Monique Roberge – b. circa 1813/14 at St-Elzéar, Co. Beauce, Québec.
7. Charles Pageot – b. circa 1762, prob. at Charlesbourg, Québec; d. before 1820. Farmer. = Françoise Bédard – b. circa 1765, prob. at Charlesbourg; d. after 1821.
8. Jean-Charles Pageot – chr. 3 Nov 1731 at Charlesbourg, Québec; d. after 1762. Farmer. = Marie-Jeanne Philippe – chr. 13 Mar 1730 at Québec; d. after 1762.
9. Jean-Baptiste Pageot – chr. 1 Apr 1705 at Charlesbourg, Québec; d. before 1746, prob. at Charlesbourg. Farmer. = Marie-Thérèse Jobin – chr. 11 Jun 1710 at Charlesbourg; d. after 1752.
10. Jean-Baptiste Pageot – chr. 3 May 1682 at Charlesbourg, Québec; d. 5 Feb 1708 at Charlesbourg. Farmer. = Marie Paradis – chr. 4 Feb 1684 at Charlesbourg; d. 24 May 1715 at Charlesbourg.
11. Thomas Pageot – b. circa 1640 at St-Agnan (Sarthe) in Mans, France; d. 14 Mar 1706 at Charlesbourg, Québec. = Marie-Catherine Roy – chr. 11 Jun 1659 at Québec; d. after 1703, prob. at Charlesbourg.
12. Thomas Pageot – resident of St-Agnan (Sarthe) in Mans, France. = Catherine Rouax. Both died before 1675.

9th Branch – The Family at Eyvindarmúli in Fljótshlíð

5. Ólöf Jónsdóttir – b. 28 Aug 1843 at Hlíðarendi in Fljótshlíð; d. 23 Oct 1924 at Vestmannaeyjar. Housewife, she lived most of her life at Brekkur in Hvolhreppur.
6. Jón Þórðarson – b. 12 Feb 1813 at Eyvindarmúli in Fljótshlíð; d. 10 Jun 1903 at Eyvindarmúli. Farmer at Hlíðarendi from 1841 until 1845; farmer at Eyvindarmúli from

1845 until 1903. Member of the *Álþing* from 1847 until 1849. = Steinnunn Auðunsdóttir, daughter of Séra Auðun Jónsson (1770-1817) – b. 27 Dec 1817; d. 26 May 1890.

7. Þórður Jónsson of Eyvindarmúli – b. 1773; d. 12 May 1845. Farmer at Eyvindarmúli and director of the poor-law district. = Ólöf Beinteinsdóttir – b. 1775; d. 15 Jul 1843.
8. Jón Ísleiksson of Eyvindarmúli – b. 1726; d. 23 Jun 1805. Farmer at Eyvindarmúli.
9. Ísleikur Ólafsson of Mortunga in Siðu – b. 1690.
10. Ólafur Höskuldsson of Hlíð by Eyjaföllum – b. circa 1650; d. circa 1700.
11. Höskuld Hannesson of Hlíð.
12. Hannes Crumbecks 'the Englishman' – b. at Lambafell. Herbalist at Lambafell around 1600.

6. Jón Sigfússon – b. 1797 in Staðarsókn in Norðuramtíæ d. 1857. Farmer at Þorbrandsstaðir and later at Refstaðir, where he died. = Mekkin Gissuraradóttir – b. 1809, the daughter of Gissur Gissurarsson and Sigríður Bjarnadóttir (b. 1776).
7. Sigfús *flangrari* Jónsson = Randiður Einaradóttir.

6. Davíð Bjarnason of Lárkot – b. 1822. Farmer at Lárkot. = Margrét Þorsteinsdóttir, sister Elías J. Kjærnested's wife, Ólöf Þorsteinsdóttir.
7. Bjarni (Hnaua-Bjarni) Jónsson – b. 1760; d. at Stykkishólmur. = Guðfinna Jónsdóttir, the daughter of Séra Jón Oddsson Hjaltalín, b. 1792; d. after 1860.

6. Charles Fontaine – b. circa 1803, prob. in Ste-Marie de Beauce or St-Nicholas de Lévis; d. prob. after 1845. Farmer. = Marie-Angélique Lehoux – b. circa 1807; d. prob. after 1845.
7. Pierre-Noel Fontaine – b. before 1775, prob. in St-Michel de Bellechasse or Ste-Marie de Beauce. Farmer. = Marguerite Dubois – b. circa 1780; died before 1819.
8. Jean-Baptiste Fontaine – chr. 23 Jun 1723 at St-Jean, Ile d'Orléans, Québec; died prob. after 1780. Farmer at Ste-Marie de Beauce. = Marie-Françoise Fortier, daughter of Joseph Fortier, a "notaire-royale" – chr. 28 Jan 1736 at St-Jean, Ile d'Orléans, Québec; d. prob. after 1780.
9. Antoine Fontaine – b. circa 1708, prob. at St-Jean, Ile d'Orléans, Québec; d. prob. after 1775. = Marguerite-Angélique Godbout – chr. 11 feb 1703 at St-Laurent, Ile d'Orléans, Québec; d. after 1775.
