MEET THE COACHES



Womens Soccer - William Wiens: William was hired in 2008 to direct the women's soccer program. Previous to CMU, William has worked as an assistant coach with Lucania FC, a local powerhouse in the Manitoba Major Soccer League and winners of the Challenge Cup - Men's Soccer Championship in 2000.



Mens Soccer - Russell Willms: Russell served as an assistant under Walter McKee in the U of M women's program and prior to the Bisons, as a co-coach at Providence College alongside Martin Ward. Russell and Ward received two coaching honors during their two years together, being named NCCAA regional coaches of the year in 2002 and 2003.



Womens Volleyball - Andrea Charbonneau: Andrea has been extremely successful, winning conference championships in 2007 and 2008. As an athlete, Andrea led the U of W to a National silver medal in 2003 and was selected to the Canadian National women's team in 2001 and 2002. Upon graduation, Andrea played professionally in France.



Mens Volleyball - Mark Kliewer: In 2008, Mark led the Blazers to a third-place finish in the conference championship after a successful showing in the Seneca College Tournament in Toronto, where CMU finished third. Mark has coached Team Manitoba U-17 boys since 2008.



Womens Basketball - Alex Leaver: The Blazers finished second in the MCAC championships in 2008, where Alex played a instrumental role in player development as an assistant coach. As an athlete, Alex led the mens team to conference championships in 07/08 when he was also recognized as the Male Athlete of the Year.



Mens Basketball - Darcy Coss: Darcy comes to CMU with an exceptional resume as both a player and coach. Darcy was a stand-out university athlete with the Manitoba Bisons men's basketball team from 2005 - 2008. Darcy was a team captain for 3 seasons with the Herd and was selected as MVP of men's basketball in 2007.



Mens Hockey - Jason Wicklund: Jason has led the Blazers to conference championships in each of the last two seasons. As an athlete, Jason skated in the Alberta Colleges Athletics Conference with the Briercrest Clippers, leading the team in penalty minutes in 2000.
