

Common Fouls

Are Normal Contact Fouls

- Illegal Use of Hands
- Blocking
- Holding
- Pushing
- Charging
- Illegal Screening
- Swinging of Elbows with Accidental Contact

Results of Common Fouls

- Team possession of non-offending team at sideline or end-line

OR

Non-offending team gets 3, 2, or 1 shot (s)

- Are always a personal foul (towards 5) and team foul (towards penalty) and occur during playing time only (Ball is alive or dead!)

Technical Fouls

Are administrative and do not involve contact

- Foul Language
- Hanging on the Rim
- Delay of Game
- Taunting or Baiting
- Continuous or Vulgar Disrespect
- Excessive Swinging of Elbows without Contact

Results of Technical Fouls

- Any player on non-offending team gets 2 shots, and get possession of the ball at center
- First of 2 or 3 T's towards ejection for coach or assistant coach (First of 2 – 5 for players)
- Player personal foul and team foul if T given to a non-substitute (Player on the floor). Otherwise, this is neither a personal nor a team foul.
- If 2nd T (or more) disqualifies player, player is ejected and must leave the gym.

Unsportsmanlike Fouls

Irregular Contact Fouls

- Have Excessive Contact
- Involve a Break Away
- Is a Defensive Foul During a Throw-in BEFORE the throw-in is released
- Excessive Swinging of Elbows with Contact

Results of Unsportsmanlike Fouls

- Foul is assessed one of their two unsportsmanlike fouls towards disqualification
- Player who gets fouled gets 2 shots (or 1 shot if the basket was successful) and that player's team gets possession of the ball at center
- Always a player and team foul

Unsportsmanlike Fouls DO NOT Warrant Disqualification unless a player gets two. A player who gets two is not ejected and may sit on the bench

Disqualifying Fouls

Severe and/or Irregular (Non-) Contact Fouls

- Severe / Violent Contact
- Fighting
- Severe Violent Behaviour
- (Repetitive and Borderline T, Unsporting and/or D.Q. Conduct)

All D.Q.ing Fouls have a disqualification attached to it.

Results of Disqualifying Fouls

- Player who commits this foul is disqualified and ejected (Must leave gym)
- Player who is fouled (Unless it is a D.Q.ing T, then anyone can shoot) gets 2 shots (or 1 shot if the basket was successful) and that player's team gets possession of the ball at center
- This is a team foul if foul given to a non-substitute player. Otherwise, this is neither a personal nor a team foul.

Results on the Scoresheet

- Technical Fouls get a "T" in the margin.
- Unsportsmanlike Fouls get a "U" in the margin
- Disqualifying Fouls get a "D" in the margin
