## FACILITY DESCRIPTION

### **Indoor Arena:**

Our spacious 20 X 60m indoor arena is well lit with halogen lights. The footing is sand and is maintained at least once/week. There is an equipment and viewing area at the end of the ring that reduces the ring to about 50m long, but can be removed if 60m is required.

### **Clubhouse:**

The heated clubhouse provides a small meeting room, washroom and kitchen area. From the clubhouse participants can see into the indoor ring.

### **Outdoor ring:**

The large outdoor ring is also Sand with board and bayco surround fencing.

### **Track:**

A short perimeter trail is available to walk horses for cool out/warm up.

### **Equipment:**

Equipment available for use must be arranged for ahead of time.

- Poles
- Standards
- Cones
- Barrels
- Trail gate

### **Parking:**

Ample trailer and car parking is available. However it is NOT pull through.

### **Stabling:**

No stabling is available at this time.
