

Minutes of the Langford Lake Area Protection Society Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 18:57

1. Minutes of last meeting, March 23, 2006. Motion: to accept as posted on the website. Bob /Steve – all were in favour – carried.
2. Business arising
  - a. Weed harvester. There is increased growth in some areas and decreased growth in others.
  - b. 2005 Society Report has been filed.
  - c. Bull frogs. Purnima gave an update on the bull frog population and the fungus they carry. Residents described where they had seen or captured frogs. Egg masses are flat, large (20,000 eggs) and almost transparent. Eggs are the size of peppercorns.
  - d. Crime on the lake. Morry was not at the meeting.
  - e. Boat trailer rinsing. Morry was not at the meeting.
  - f. Trucks on Goldstream. Dan was not present at the meeting.
  - g. Speed traps. None has been set-up.
  - h. Neighbourhood watch. Ron handed out stickers to those present at the meeting for their homes and those of their neighbours.
3. New business
  - a. Survey of those attending the meeting – important issues. Lake health, controlling lakeshore development, lakeshore buffer zone or park land along the lake, berm to protect lake from new roads and development and to reduce noise, uncontrolled run-off into lake, drinking in the park and discarded bottles and cans, more participation in lake protection, vandalism, weed harvester program and getting sufficient volunteers, lake monitoring, noise abatement measures on the new development and Eng property, development pressures and affects on water quality, drainage at the end of Glen Lake, garbage and waste disposal issues, crime, pesticide and herbicide use, lake water quality monitoring
  - b. BCLSS volunteer insurance coverage – for lake monitoring and not for weed harvester operators.
4. Next Meeting – July – precise date, time and location to be determine by the chair.
